Tour Itinerary

Monday 22nd June 2020

We depart this morning for National Trust East Riddlesden Hall which was once a thriving farming estate. Today the house tells tales of the ambition, success and failure of those who lived and worked here. In the barn see craftsmen's markings made 400 years ago and enjoy the extensive gardens; cottage garden flowers, colourful borders and a wild garden. We then continue our journey to our hotel the 'New Lanark Mill', our home for the next 4 nights. (D)

Tuesday 23rd June 2020

Today we enjoy a 'coach free day', as our hotel is part of the New Lanark Mill World Heritage Site. We take a short walk to the New Lanark Mill Visitor Centre, with its fantastic riverside location near the Falls of Clyde. Take part in a guided tour, then enjoy free time to explore the fascinating on-site museum, which gives an insight into life at this 18th-century cotton mill. You may wish to take the walking trail along the river to the stunning Falls of Clyde. (B,D)

Wednesday 24th June 2020

This morning we head towards Glasgow with our first stop at Tenement House. Frozen in time, all four rooms of this historic museum capture a snapshot of life in the early 20th century. We then head to the Kelvingrove museum which opened in 1901. Marvel at the stunning architecture and explore a few of its 22 galleries from Ancient Egypt to Charles Rennie Mackintosh. This afternoon we take in National Trust Pollok House - undoubtedly one of the grandest in their care. This elegant stately home is an excellent example of Georgian Grandeur, which wouldn't seem out of place in a 'Jane Austen' novel. Pollok's crowning glory is its art collection and downstairs, tiled passageways are an eye-opener to the scale of work it took to run this magnificent house. (B,D)

Thursday 25th June 2020

Our first visit this morning will be to the National Trust Culross Palace, an ochre-coloured building located in the heart of the community. A picture perfect village of white-harled, red tiled roofed houses lining the cobbled streets that run from the market cross to the hilltop abbey. No wonder the village has been used in the television series "Outlander". We then continue to Edinburgh, the capital city of Scotland, where we have a short amount of free time to explore before we meet our guide and enjoy a sightseeing tour from the comfort of our coach. Friday 26th June 2020

After breakfast, we say goodbye to the New Lanark Mill, heading to National Trust Sizergh Castle, a beautiful medieval house and rich gardens, set in a 1600 acre estate of limestone pastures, orchards and natural woodland. The house itself has centuries old portraits and fine furniture. Mid-afternoon we depart Sizergh Castle with wonderful memories of the holiday, arriving back into Staffordshire early evening. (B)
